

American Academy of Periodontology Education Consultant

The American Academy of Periodontology (AAP) is currently seeking an experienced Periodontist with extensive experience with periodontal education to serve as an independent Education Consultant.

The Education Consultant will provide expert guidance to the AAP Education Committee; Manager, Governance and Education; and Associate Executive Director, Governance, Advocacy and Education on issues related to periodontal education, at both the predoctoral and postdoctoral levels.

The ideal candidate will be well-versed in innovative education models; advances in the art and science of periodontology; and various educational methodologies, pedagogy, and curriculum development. In addition, the candidate should have a strong understanding of the Commission on Dental Accreditation, its processes, and the periodontal education standards.

Additional qualifications include:

- Board certified
- Experience in a periodontal academic setting;
- Strong understanding of the challenges unique to pre- and postdoctoral periodontal education;
- Experience with conducting scholarly research relevant to periodontology;
- Understanding of the AAP In-Service Examination
- Excellent communications skills

The Education Consultant will serve as an independent contractor to the AAP and will help the AAP navigate the changing landscape of periodontal education, identify trends and propose strategic solutions to advance and improve periodontal training. The Education Consultant must be available via email and phone for consultation and advice as needed. Attendance at two to three in-person meetings a year and participation on conference call meetings will be required. To be effective, a candidate should be able to dedicate a portion of his or her weekly schedule to this role and should expect to dedicate approximately 10-15 hours per month to the position. An honorarium based on experience will be negotiated. Appointment will be for a one-year, renewable, term.
